Apologies I noticed the mail merge did not pull through the formatting correctly, so I am resending.

In preparation for next year's Local Elections, we have calculated the estimated costs for Groton.

You will see that there is an increase on the figures we supplied for 2019, this is driven by a rise in the cost of paper, printing, postage, and staffing.

- For a Contested Election combined with the District Council Election the estimated fee would be £833.56
- For a standalone Contested Election, the estimated fee would be £964.60
- For an Un-Contested Election, the estimated fee would be £123.71

The figures given above are based on our current understanding of the costs and are subject to change.
