 - 4.1 Suffolk County Council Councillor J Finch reported the following:

SCC was working closely with bus companies to ensure safe travel for children returning to school. Three types of transport; Dedicated School buses, shared buses and public transport. No need for children to socially distance on dedicated buses but need to do so on shared routes or public transport.

Thanks passed on from Councillor Mary Evans to school's staff for their dedication and hard work to ensure safe returns for pupils.

SCC Highways had completed 1,000 miles of road resurfacing as per the Council's commitment made in 2017.

£1,000 grants being offered to small and medium-sized businesses across Suffolk and Norfolk who take on new apprentices between the ages of 16-24.
